Annual Report For the 2018-19 Municipal Year

<u>1. Summary of major points.</u>

- The Precept was set at £73,000. Band D of £18.23. (35p per house, per week).
- The Council closed and removed the Heath Hayes Cabin.
- The Council also provides the Hayes Green Community Centre. Owing to the loss of the main hirer, income was reduced from £27,422 in 16/17 to £23,981 in 17/18 and then £12,487 in 18/19. It is hoped that income will stabilise and the aim is to use the Centre for a more varied and diversified community use.
- The Council has an annual grants programme and awarded £4,105 to local organisations.

2. Introduction.

The Council, in Cannock Chase, Staffordshire, has 13 Councillors representing the four wards of New Heath Hayes, Old Heath Hayes, Hawks Green and Wimblebury. Four Councillors represent Old Heath Hayes and three each for New Heath Hayes, Hawks Green and Wimblebury.

Since September 2018, the Council now meets at the Hayes Green Community Centre, Heath Hayes at 7.30pm on the first Wednesday of each month except August. Previously all meetings except for the Annual Parish Meeting were held at Heath Hayes Library.
